It is 15 feet long x 66 inches wide at the skid.

The tank is 48 inch dia.

The overall height to top of cowling when closed is 74 inches.

Owner is not sure on weight, but a guess would be about 3000 lbs.

How it ships:

It can be transported behind a pick up on a trailer similar to the one in the picture which is not included. Other options would be standard shipping methods. We could load it a cover with a tarp. We would put the misc. Pieces that were removed and new windows inside. Full payment required before it leaves our yard.
